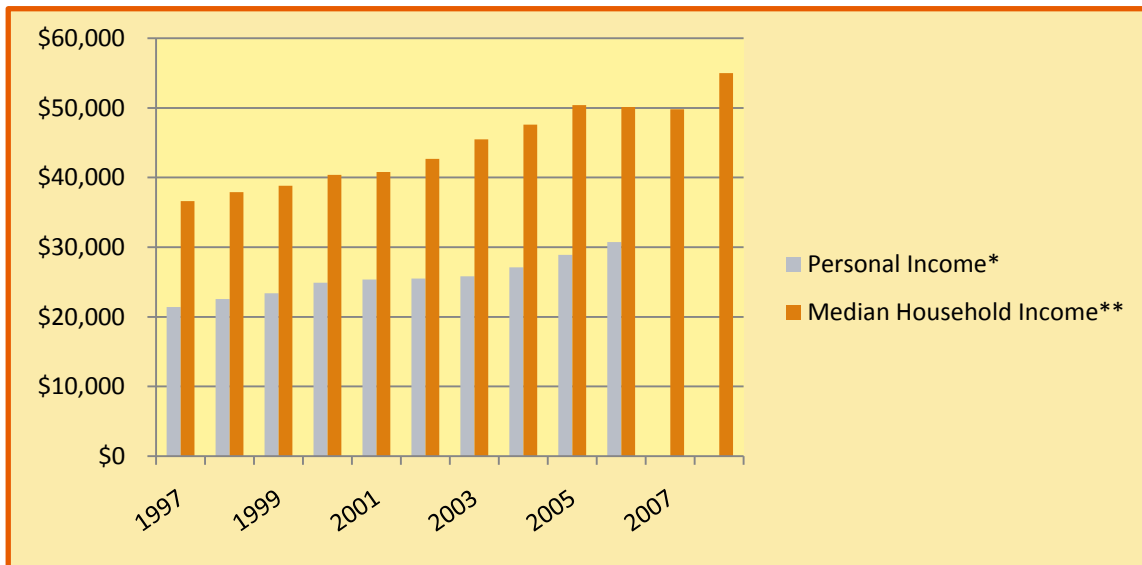

Per capita personal income is calculated as the personal income of residents of a given area divided by the resident population of the area. In computing per capita personal income, BEA uses the Census Bureau's annual midyear population estimates.

In 2006 Mesa Co. had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$30,746. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$39,491, and 84 percent of the national average, \$36,714. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.3 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 5.0 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Mesa was \$19,972 and ranked 34th in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.
